## Science News for Term 2

"It's Electrifying" was the title of the unit the Grade 5 \& 6 students worked on this term in Science. Students have worked very hard on learning all about circuits, switches and how they are used to make all sorts of devices work. One of the highlights of this term has been the way students have worked cooperatively and persistently to achieve an outcome. The Preps unit was "On the Move", the Grade $1 \& 2$ unit was "Push Pull" and the Grade 3 \& 4 unit was "Smooth Moves". All of these developed the language and knowledge of movement and how we use that every day. Of course the Preps loved moving because it is lots of fun but at the same time they were learning about which parts of their bodies were moving when they were running, hopping, skipping, twirling and rolling. They were also introduced to the idea of a 'fair test' where they checked out how the surface of a ramp affected the movement of a toy car.
Grade $1 \& 2$ took these ideas even further by looking at how things move in the air, in water and on the ground. There were many hands on experiments with large tubs of water, paper helicopters and toy cars. These students are also learning to set up an investigation where they are able to test ideas and questions they may have.
The Grade 3 \& 4 students learnt a lot about 'Forcearrow Diagrams' that they were able to use to describe the strength and direction of forces. Again there were lots of hands on activities including a tug of war, moving different shaped objects over a variety of surfaces and testing spinners in the wind.
