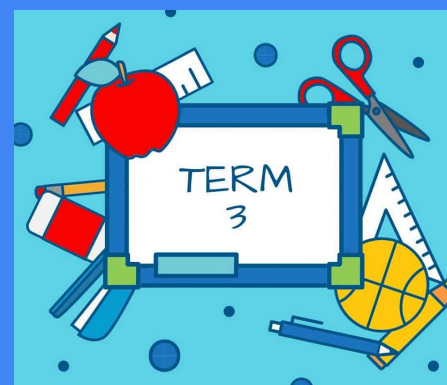

Welcome to Term 3. I am looking forward to continuing to see what amazing work your children will create this term. This term we will be focusing on **Collage**.

Foundation: Students will explore collage by cutting, tearing and arranging a variety of materials to create artworks that communicate their ideas, experiences and observations.

Grades 1 & 2: Students will experiment with different collage techniques and materials, developing their understanding of colour, shape and texture while creating imaginative artworks.

Grades 3 & 4: Students will use collage to explore composition and visual storytelling, combining materials and techniques to express ideas and represent personal experiences.

Grades 5 & 6: Students will investigate how artists use collage to communicate meaning. They will plan and create layered artworks that demonstrate creativity, purpose and an understanding of visual conventions.

We will be using a lot of recycled materials. The following donations would be greatly appreciated.
