Hi Everyone,

Welcome Back to Term Four!

Term 4 is important for every Victorian student, and our teachers will strive to deliver high-quality learning for everyone. Term 4 is making sure that every student is supported in their wellbeing, learning and transition needs.

This term, we are very excited about our students returning to full-time on-site schooling!

Staged Return of Students

From **Monday 18th October** Foundation students will return three days a week, Monday through to Wednesday, Year 1 and 2 students will attend on Thursday and Friday, two days a week.

From **Tuesday 26th October** all school students will return at least part-time: On this date, arrangements for Foundation students and Year 1 and 2 students will continue; Year 3 to 4 will attend on Tuesday and Wednesday; Year 5 and 6 will attend on Thursday and Friday.

Please note, we will continue to provide remote and flexible learning for year levels not scheduled for onsite learning.

Please be assured we will be focused on these key priorities in Term 4:

Mental Health and Wellbeing

Our highest priority will be the wellbeing, particularly the mental health, of every student and member of staff. This means effectively mobilising all available resources to support our most vulnerable students and enabling staff to access the relevant support services.

Learning and Excellence

Some of our students have thrived in the remote and flexible learning environment, others have maintained their learning progress, and some have fallen behind, despite their best efforts and those of their families and teachers. Our priority will be supporting both those who need to catch up and those who have progressed to continue to extend their learning.

Transitions

We will make every effort to ensure successful transitions for children moving from kindergarten into Foundation and the Year 6 students moving into Year 7.

Ventilation

All schools are required to increase fresh air flow into indoor spaces (including shared spaces, staff areas and thoroughfares) whenever possible. While we wait on the delivery of air purifiers, I have conducted an inspection of all windows and doors to ensure ventilation can occur in all learning spaces.

PLANNING- 2022

As mentioned in previous newsletters, it is now extremely important that parents with children due to start Foundation in 2022 enrol their child as soon as possible as it is important that we have these numbers locked in, to enable us to organise our staffing needs, grade structures and numbers, along with budgetary requirements for 2022. If your child/children won't be attending Gladstone Views Primary School next year, it's important you let us know by contacting the office on 9338 6083.

Camps

At this stage, we are still planning for the **Years 5 & 6** Portsea Camp and the **Years 3 & 4** Arrabri Lodge Camp to still go ahead. If you would like your child/ren to participate on the camps, please make sure you pay the deposit as soon as possible. This will allow us to finalise the camp numbers. Please note: if the camps do not take place, parents will receive a full refund.




Fabulous FNU!
