Hi Everyone,

It is with great pleasure and relief that we welcomed every student from Foundation to Year Six, back through the school gates on Wednesday morning!

The staged return of students went incredibly smoothly and students quickly transitioned back into the routine of school life. It has been wonderful having all the students return back to school and to see the school grounds filled with smiles and laughter!

With the return of students, we are very mindful of the precautions we are required to take to ensure that we do not risk a school closure due to exposure to the COVID virus. Some of the measures we are taking are as follows:



- Face masks mandated to be worn indoors by all staff, visitors and students from Years 3 to 6
- QR Code check ins are required for any parent, carer, volunteer or visitor entering the school
- Parents, carers, volunteers and visitors onsite to meet, help or work, must be fully vaccinated and be able to provide evidence of their vaccination status upon request
- Ventilation across classrooms is enabled by keeping doors and windows open and teachers are encouraged to utilise outdoor spaces
- A cleaner is on site all day, focussing on high impact areas such as door handles, benches, taps, chairs and tables.

If a child is unwell or shows COVID type symptoms, they should be kept at home, likewise if they are unwell at school you will be called to come and collect your child.



This week as students return to school, we will be able to draw upon our existing approach to wellbeing. Relationships are central to belonging and connectedness in the school environment.

To promote a positive return to school, the staff at Gladstone Views Primary School will:

- Recognise each student will have different experiences and reactions
- Establish and maintain routines and a calm classroom
- Provide reassurance that school is a safe place to be
- Support social skills by including social and emotional learning in the classroom
- Build connectedness to school

While as a staff, we will do our utmost to support our students, it is often the case that their true emotions are only shown when they are with their families. If you have any concerns about how your child is coping with the return, please do not hesitate to speak with your child's classroom teacher.

Teachers are in the process of writing reports for Semester Two. As part of the report writing process, teachers have been involved in moderation sessions which allows for consistent teacher judgement across all year levels. All teacher reports are proofread by the Leadership Team. Reports will be sent home via Compass on **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> December**.
