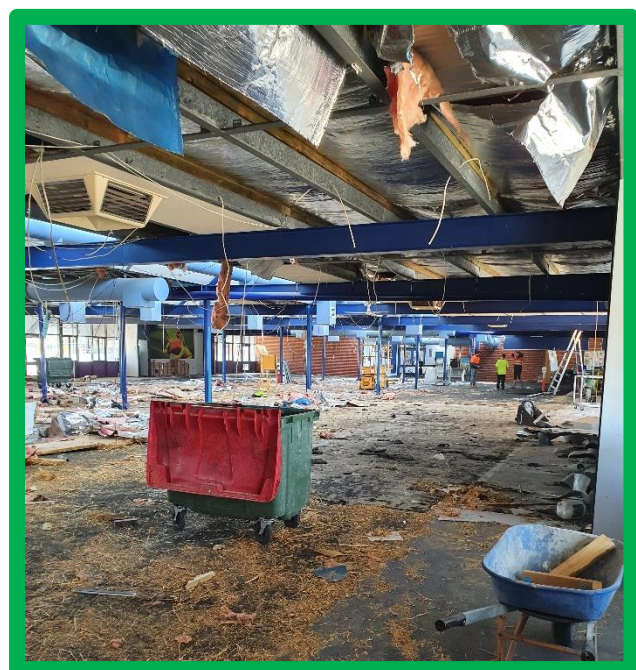

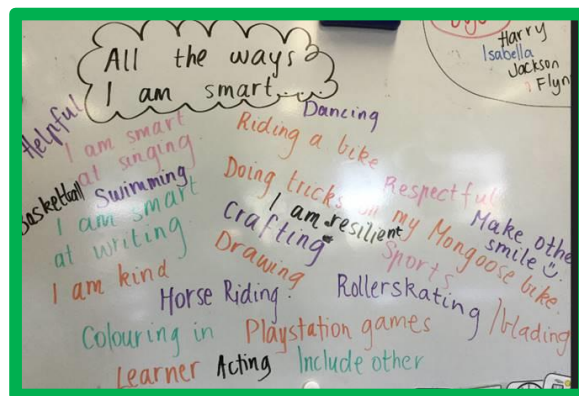
## THANK YOU!
