Hi Everyone,

I trust that you all continue to be well.

Northern Region Principal Conference: held Thursday 18th – Friday 19th August 2022.

Our Acting Assistant Principal and I last week attended the 2022 Northern Region Principal Conference in Geelong. This is an annual event where all our local network school Principals and Assistant Principals meet to hear the most up to date information and learning coming from the Department of Education, and it also allows us an opportunity to collaborate with other schools nearest to us who face similar successes and challenges.

Day 1 of the conference was based around the implementation of FISO 2.0 (Framework for Improving Student Outcomes) with the lens on student wellbeing.

The FISO 2.0 comprises of:

- 1. the 2 outcomes of learning and wellbeing
- 2. the 5 core elements of leadership, teaching and learning, assessment, engagement, and support and resources
- 3. the 10 dimensions that underpin the elements and, indicate priority areas of practice to improve students' learning and wellbeing.

This is the framework that will form the basis of all our work moving forward.

Day 2 focussed on the implementation if the new Victorian Government Schools Agreement (VGSA) which recently came into effect. Our school will gradually implement various changes in order to comply with the VGSA.

Some of the key features of the agreement are:

- provision for reduction of maximum face-to-face teaching hours allocated to teachers as provided for in the deed of agreement
- provision for Professional Practice Days for teachers
- enhanced time in lieu provisions for teachers and education support class employees.

As we make these and other changes within the new agreement, we will endeavour to inform you about those that will have a direct impact on student learning.

WE WANT OUR PARENTS/CAREGIVERS/GUARDIANS TO TELL US WHAT THEY THINK!

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what parents/caregivers/guardians think of our school. The Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education and Training that is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate, student behavior, and student engagement. We encourage all families to participate in this survey. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies.

While previously a random sample of approximately 30 per cent of parents/caregivers/guardians have been selected to participate, this year, all families are invited to participate in the survey.

The Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey will be conducted from **Monday 15**th **August** to **Friday 16th September.**

The survey will be conducted **online**, only takes **20 minutes** to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the fieldwork period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in a range of languages other than English. These include: Arabic, Vietnamese, Simplified Chinese, Chin (Hakha), Hindi, Japanese, Somali, Turkish, Punjabi and Greek.

Staffing Update

As in most schools at the moment, staffing changes continue to impact our day to day operations. As mentioned in the previous newsletter, we had teaching positions advertised to fill positions made vacant by staff moving on to other opportunities. We only had three applicants in which two satisfied the requirements for consideration and employment.

The 2 new staff members will be joining us week beginning Monday 29th August, in a part-time capacity. Mrs Daniela Scarpino will begin Monday 29th Aug and will work on Monday to Wednesday and Mrs Monica Pisani will being on Wednesday 31st Aug and will work Wednesday to Friday. Both ladies will be placed in Gr 4 ML.

We wish to congratulate Miss Maddison Lomiglio for being successful in attain ongoing employment at Gaayip-Yagila Primary School, commencing Monday 12th September. Miss Lomiglio will work closely with the above mentioned two new staff members

We unfortunately have been unable to find suitable teaching staff to fill other positions made vacant recently. Due to the teacher shortage being faced statewide, a decision in consultation with teaching staff and our schools consultative committee was made to dissolve Gr 1 JR into the other Gr 1 and 2 classes as was to for the dissolving of Gr 6 CN into the Gr 5 and 6 classes. We as the leadership group of the school will monitor with above changes and place adequate supports, as necessary.

The recently re-advertised substantive principal position closes shortly, and a new process will begin. I will inform you as soon as an outcome is reached.


