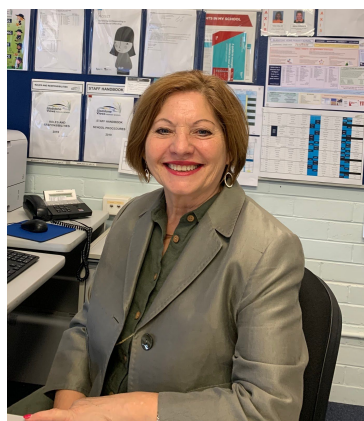

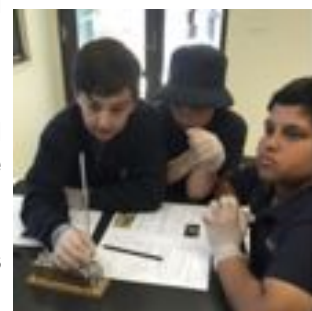
I wish everyone a happy ending to the year and good luck for all future adventures.

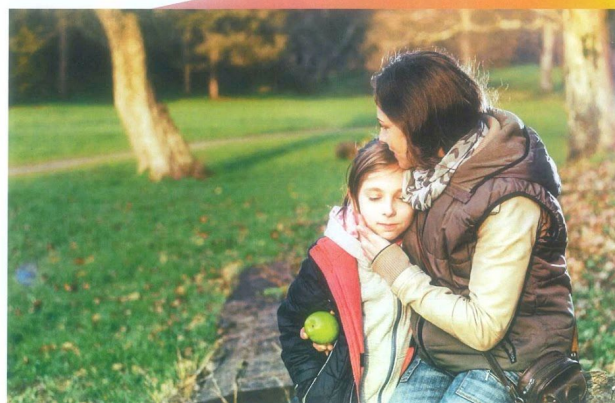
